**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-04**

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTION 28(B) OF CHAPTER 14 – AGENCY DESIGNATED - OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE AND TRANSFER RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF ITS ELECTRICAL CODE TO THE COUNTY OF EATON UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT OF 1972 (ACT 230 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1972, AS AMENDED).

Councilmember Sanders moved the following:

THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE ORDAINS:

**Section 1.** Pursuant to the provisions of Section 8b(7) of the State Construction Code Act of 1972, as amended, the City of Charlotte hereby transfers responsibility for the administration and enforcement of its Electrical Code provisions to the County of Eaton.

**Section 2.** All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall be considered an emergency ordinance under the provisions of Section 5.3(B) and shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
