 - d) That all repairs will be performed by the City of Charlotte and billed to the Contractor.
 - e) To inform the DPW as soon as the meter is no longer needed.
- 2) Water may only be drawn from the meter and hydrant issued.
- 3) During operation, only the auxiliary valve shall be used for volume control; the hydrant valve shall not be throttled but used only in the full open or full closed position.
- 4) The hydrant shall remain accessible to the Fire Department at all times.
