SUBJECT: City Manager's Report

**Owens-Brockway.** I previously reported to you via email that the Supreme Court has rejected the applications for leave to appeal submitted by Owens-Brockway. City Attorney Tom Hitch has discussed with the Owens-Brockway attorney arrangements for the wire transfer of the funds owed to the City. I expect a date for that transfer to be established so that an accurate calculation of interest can be made. Staff is preparing to do the calculation of the distributions to the other taxing jurisdictions of their respective shares of the amount. When we know the total amount to be transferred to the City we will be able to inform Council as to the exact amount that will be our share.

**Union Negotiations.** Negotiations with the Police Supervisory bargaining unit commenced this week and good progress was made. An additional bargaining session has been scheduled for later in February. In addition, the first bargaining session has been scheduled with the Police Patrol unit, also later this month.
