AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE VI, CHAPTER 34 -
OFFENSES - OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE
BY ADDING SECTION 34-13 TO MAKE FURNISHING
FALSE INFORMATION TO A POLICE OFFICER ILLEGAL
WITHIN THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE.

Councilmember Russo moved the following:

THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE ORDAINS:

Section 34-13 of Chapter 34 - Offenses - of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby added to read as follows:

Sec. 34-13. False information to police officer. No person shall furnish to a peace officer false, forged, fictitious, or misleading verbal or written information either identifying the person as another person or falsely misrepresenting a material fact about the person including, but not limited to, the person's date of birth or correct spelling of their full name, if the person is detained for a violation of the law, is temporarily detained for the purpose of the issuance of an appearance ticket or civil infraction citation, or has an outstanding warrant for their arrest.

This ordinance shall become effective 20 days after adoption and that the above ordinance be passed to a second reading.
