

In November 2018, Proposal 3 was passed and this included No Reason Absentee Voting. The City of Charlotte Clerk's office is reaching out to you with the opportunity to be on our permanent absent voter list. This means that you automatically receive a ballot application for each election. The process is then as follows:

1. Complete and return application to the Clerk's office
2. Watch for your ballot in the mail
3. Complete and return ballot with signature on the envelope as directed to the Clerk's office

Your ballot is then counted on Election Day and added to the totals from the precinct.

If you wish to be on the permanent absent voter list, please complete and return the attached form.
