
Re: Request for sale and consumption of alcohol per Council Policy

Dear City Council -

The Michigan Nordic Fire Festival is requesting permission to sell and consume alcohol at 615 West Shepherd Street, otherwise known as the 'sledding hill' area, south of Lincoln Park during its festival on February 28 and 29, 2020. Per Council Policy, we are submitting the following information:

- 1.) We intend to use a 60' X 90' tent as well as perimeter fencing as required.
- 2.) We have hired paid, professional security services to provide security both inside the tent and around the perimeter area. In addition, there will be volunteer staff and trained servers present at all times.
- 3.) This will be a 'beer tent' style event with entertainment.
- 4.) We have worked with the Charlotte Police Department to plan this event, and to meet the requirements of the Michigan Liquor Control Commission. We have applied for non-profit, special event liquor licenses, copies of which will be provided to the City prior to final approval.
- 5.) We are carrying insurance in excess of that required by the City. A copy of the specific liquor endorsement will be supplied to the City prior to final approval.
