The following is my report to the City Council on issues in which our office has been engaged since the last Council meeting:

1. **City Manager separation agreement.** I have had a number of conversations with the attorney for the City Manager, Karen Schneider, and the Mayor. We have come to an agreement on a proposal which the Mayor will be presenting to the City Council at the Council Meeting. I will be attending the Council Meeting to answer any questions the City Council might have.

2. **City of Charlotte v. Brian Dunn.** As you may remember, on August 12, 2020, my associate Molly Coscarelli mailed to the City a summary of the decision of Judge Maurer in this matter. He granted the City's judgment against Brian Dunn in the amount of \$18,484, plus costs and other statutory fees.

I think this is an excellent result. The Judge did make, as set forth on the memo, certain adjustments because some of the land was not tillable due to the City's leasing the land to construct the new softball field.
