Blight, Weeds, Junk Vehicles. The City has adopted the International Property Maintenance Code. Properties must be kept in good repair, including exterior siding, roofs, and free of junk/debris. Grass and weeds cannot exceed 8" in growth. Additionally, city code states that vehicles must be registered and operable.
