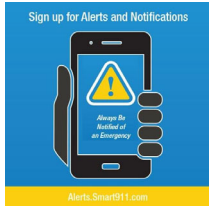

Rave Alerts. The City of Charlotte is now using Rave alerts! Get notified with important information about what is happening in the community such as street closures, water system work, or emergencies that may affect you. There are several ways to register: Text CHARLOTTE to 67283; Download the Smart911 app; Register for a free and secure safety profile online at Smart911.com.

Rental Inspection Program. City Council has approved a rental inspection program to begin in November. Landlords will be required to register their properties and pass a city inspection for safety before a certificate of compliance will be issued. Learn more at www.charlottemi.org.

DO YOU KNOW? **Blight, Weeds, or Junk Vehicles.** The City has adopted the International Property Maintenance Code. Properties must be kept in good repair, including exterior siding and roofs, and free of junk/debris. Grass and weeds cannot exceed 10" in growth. Additionally, city code states that vehicles must be registered and operable.
