Construction 2023

The City is gearing up for three major construction projects this year. Safe Routes to Schools program will install sidewalks through \$1.8mill grant funding in partnership with Charlotte Public Schools; Hall/Washington/McClure streets will be completely reconstructed, including underground utilities; and Island Hwy will be reconstructed in partnership with the Eaton County Drain Commissioner's Office.
