The following is my report to the City Council on several issues in which our office has been engaged since the last Council meeting:

1. CNIPlastics. The Defendant, Jorge Morales, has made the final payment of \$4,743.25. With this, the matter is closed and the back taxes, with interest, have been paid in full.

2. Charter Amendment. I have received a copy of the letter sent by the Attorney General making the finding that the City's proposed charter amendment complies with the provisions of the Home Rule Cities Act. I have contacted the City Clerk and advised that the proposed ballot language to amend Section 7.6 of Chapter 7 of the Charlotte City Charter may be forwarded to the County Clerk so that the proposal will be on the November ballot.

3. Sale of City Lands. The closing for ALRO Steel has occurred and the money has been transferred to the City of Charlotte. This coming Monday, August 14, 2017, a closing is set for PTSK to acquire the land adjacent to the Michel's property in the industrial park.

4. Ordinance Drafting. My office has prepared an ordinance to make it unlawful to display a fictional, forged driver's license, or to mislead a police officer by displaying the driver's license of another. The first reading may occur either at this Council meeting, or the last Council meeting in August.
