**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A BLOCK PICNIC IN THE VICINITY OF
SHELDON ROW AND WEDGEWOOD DRIVE, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE
NECESSARY STREET CLOSURE AND BARRICADE PLACEMENT**

WHEREAS, The City of Charlotte has received a request for the temporary closure of Wedgewood Drive and the placement of barricades for a block picnic; and

WHEREAS, the block picnic would take place on Saturday, August 27, from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, location of the requested street closure is on Wedgewood Drive, just west of the intersection of Sheldon Row and Wedgewood Drive, adjacent to the north boundary of 1101 Sheldon Row; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the block picnic is to encourage and facilitate a gathering of neighbors; and

WHEREAS, block parties and similar events contribute to the overall health and welfare of the community.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Charlotte City Council hereby authorizes the August 27 block picnic, and directs the City of Charlotte Police Department to issue the necessary traffic control order, and the Department of Public Works to supply the necessary barriers.
