February 2023 Monthly Report

Monthly Statistics:

- See attached report.

Training:

- All officers completed online training in preparation for the new state mandated Intoxilizer 9000 in person training to come in April.
- All officers completed annual training where they were re-certified in First Aid/CPR, Taser, Defensive Tactics, and Force on Force training.
- Chief Brentar and Sgt. Antcliff attended the Michigan Association of Chief's of Police conference in Grand Rapids.

Operational Highlights:

- On 2-13 5 officers responded to Michigan State University for the Active Shooter Incident.
- On 2-26 officers were dispatched to Walmart for a retail fraud complaint where the subject ran from officers. He was located in the woods east of the airport and placed under arrest.
- On 2-16 an officer took a fraud complaint where the victim was scammed out of \$500 through Facebook. The investigation is on-going.
- On 2-24 an officer attempted a traffic stop on a vehicle which took off at a high rate of speed. The investigation is on-going.
- On 2-8 an officer was dispatched to a stolen vehicle complaint behind O'Reillys. The officer made contact with the subject who had multiple warrants out for his arrest, including dangerous drugs. He was lodged at the jail.
- Cold Case CSC- In 2019 Det. Poortvliet received a DNA hit from the MSP crime lab from a 2004 CSC case. This hit identified the suspect after all these years. After years of working on this case when he could, Det. Poortvliet was able to finally locate the victim in Battle Creek after a lengthy investigation with Battle Creek PD. Det. Poortvliet then conducted an extensive investigation to locate the suspect where he found out that the suspect had recently died. The case is now closed.
- On 2-28 officer responded to a Personal Injury Crash involving a car vs pedestrian. The pedestrian was transported to Sparrow-Eaton for treatment.

Outreach/Public Events:

- On 2-1 Chief Brentar, Officers McDaniel & Everts assisted with security-based scenario training at Charlotte High School for their in-service training with Emergency Management.
- Officers provided security for the Nordic Fire Festival on 2-24 and 2-25.
